**GESTLIFE HELPS COUPLES WHO HAVE A SURROGATE PROCESS WITH OTHER AGENCIES THAT HAVE CLOSED BECAUSE OF THE WAR (OR LOST CONTACT WITH THE AGENCY)**



Unfortunately, due to the war in Ukraine, some agencies and clinics have closed and it is unknown if they will reopen. This has left hundreds of parents, in the beginning or middle of a process, unable to continue, having already paid significant amounts of money, probably, lost. In some cases, such as the clinics in Kharkov, one of the hardest hit cities and the most devastated still under the bombing, they may not open for years. This war has shown the difference between local agencies and companies like Gestlife, with offices in several countries. Gestlife and its InterEco clinic continue to operate in Ukraine, despite the war.

This is why Gestlife has decided to help parents who had started a surrogacy procedure in Ukraine, and who have seen it interrupted (loss of contact with the local agency or clinic), with a subsidy (depending on the type of program undertaken), if they had already paid a part to the local clinic or agency. Our in-country legal services will also assist them in trying to recover the money paid to that agency or clinic).

In this way, they will be able to restart the process in Ukraine or in one of the countries where the company has its own offices (Georgia, Albania, USA, Greece).

In this way, we hope to help recover at least some of the money lost for some families.
